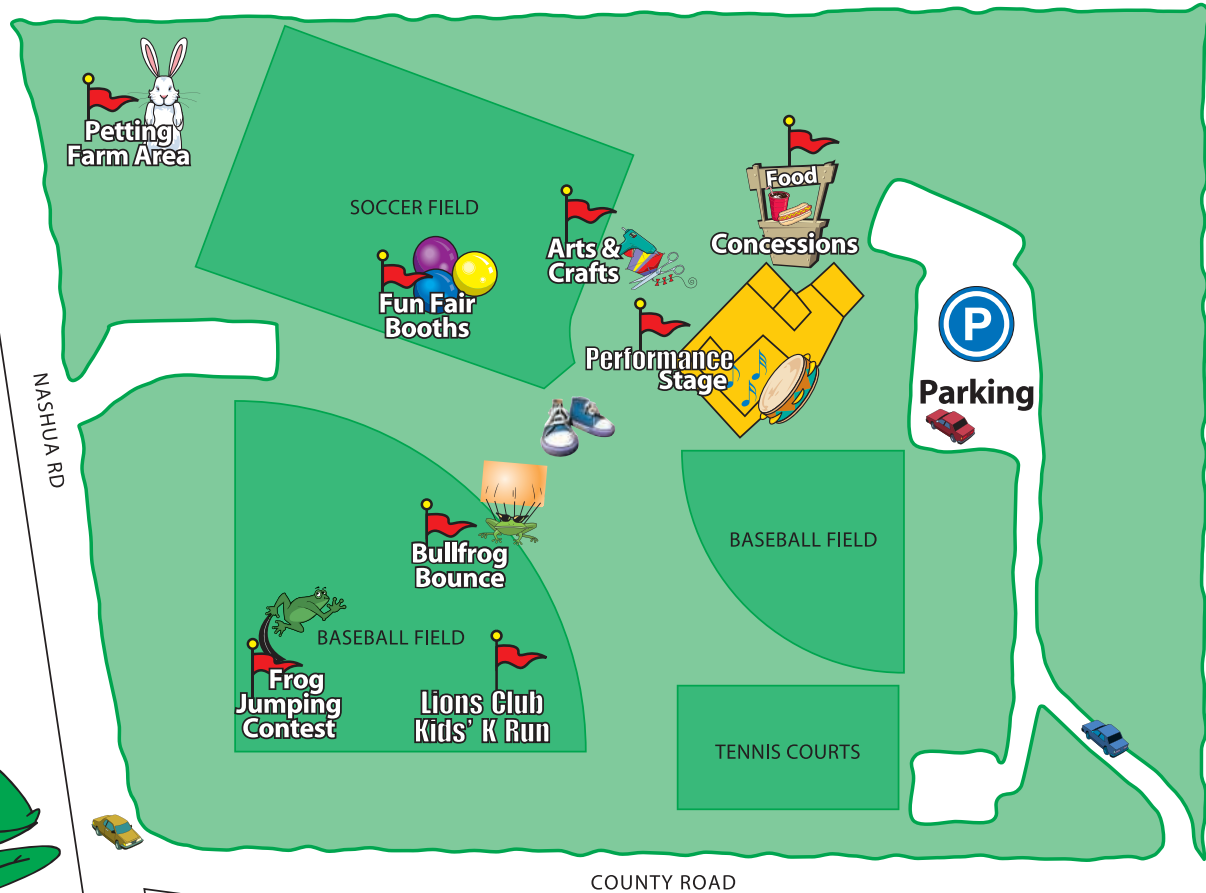

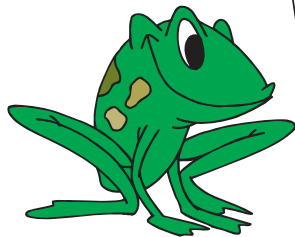

Purchase your frog tickets at the "Bull Frog Bounce Table"

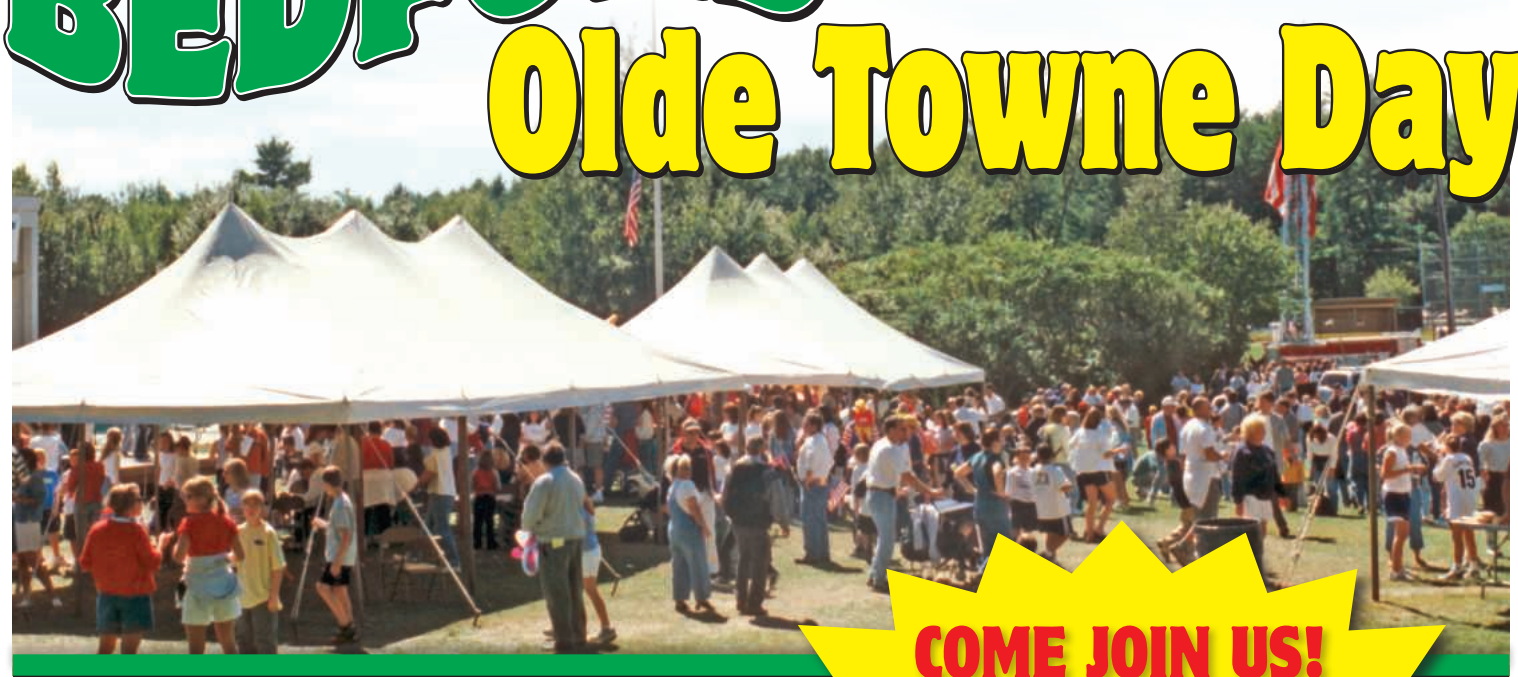
"BEDFORD'S – OPEN MIC"

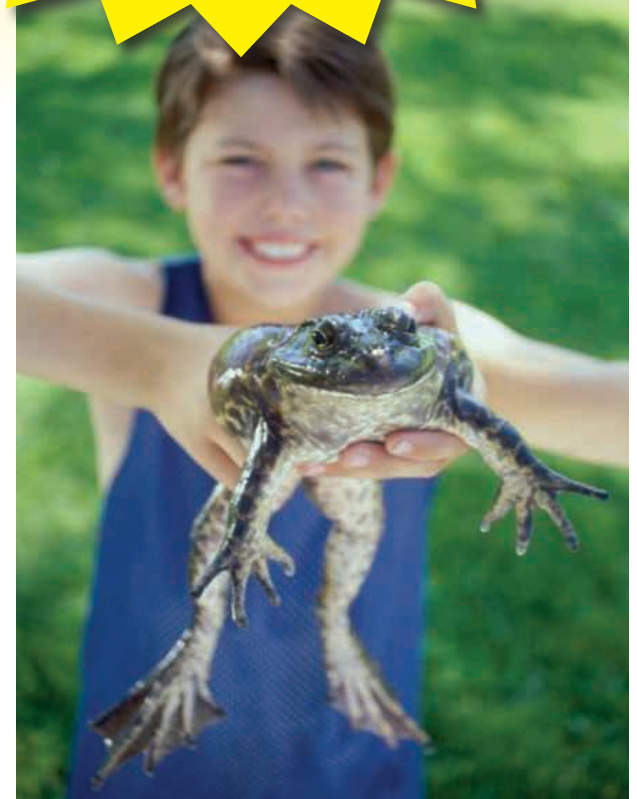

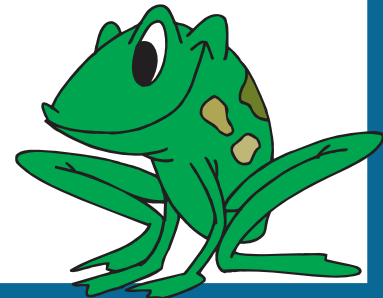
